Notice of Requirement for alteration of Designation 6766 to provide for the upgrade of the corridor, including provision of active mode facilities and realignment of the Station Road intersection with SH16.

Notice of Requirement (NOR S2 State Highway 16 Main Road)

Auckland Council has received a notice of a requirement for a alteration of a designation from Waka Kotahi NZTA as the Requiring Authority, for public work.

The requirement is for a change to the boundary of the designation and a change to the conditions of the designation to enable the Requiring Authority to:

- Provide an upgraded transport corridor to support and enable Auckland Council's growth aspirations for Auckland.
- Improve access to economic and social opportunities and improve resilience of the strategic transport network.
- Integrate future transport outcomes with Auckland Council's aspirations for land use and urban form.
- Help to address existing and increasing safety risks on transport corridors as growth areas urbanise.
- Support mode shift towards more sustainable travel choices such as public transport and walking and cycling.

The site to which the requirement applies is as follows: SH16 Main Road between Riverhead Road and Foster Road.

Making a submission on the notice of requirement

Any person or organisation may make a submission on the notice of requirement, but a person who is a trade competitor or the requiring authority may do so only if that person is directly affected by an effect of the activity to which the requirement relates that –

- (a) Adversely affects the environment; and
- (b) Does not relate to trade competition or the effects of trade competition.
