1. Windbreak to be installed onto tennis court fences
 2. Bollards to be installed to restrict access to service driveway and kayak landing pad.
 3. Kayak landing pad to not to be used for motorised vehicles and to be accessed only on foot.
 4. Existing section of path to be removed (cultural monitor to be present for all infrastructure removals)
 5. All proposed trees on site to be native
 6. All buildings will be equipped with rain water harvesting systems to be used for toilets.
 7. Storm water outlets to be treated through rain gardens.
 8. Cultural signage or pou to be installed along path
 9. Weed management required onsite, especially along stream
