Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 Re: RFA Staff remuneration

I refer to your email, which we received on 13 January 2020 requesting information about CCO Staff remuneration. Please see below the response from Regional Facilities Auckland.

1. The job titles of staff, ordered by seniority, with a total remuneration of equal to or more than one quarter of a million dollars annually, as at 30 September 2019.

2. "The amount each of those persons is remunerated annually."

We are unable to provide specific salaries in combination with job titles as this would prejudice RFA's remuneration system and RFA's ability to negotiate senior salaries that reflect the contribution, skills and experience, and market conditions for that particular role. However, we have grouped the roles into \$50,000 salary bands (apart from Band 1, which to protect individual privacy, where we have grouped all roles earning more than \$400,000):

Bands and associated salaries

Band 1- \$400,000 and above Band 2- \$350,000 - \$399,999 Band 3- \$300,000 - \$349,999 Band 4- \$250,000 - \$299,999 Therefore, this information is withheld under section 7(2)(a) and (i) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA).

Should you believe Auckland Council has not responded appropriately to your request, you have the right by way of complaint, under section 27(3) of the LGOIMA, to apply to the Ombudsman to seek an investigation and review of the decision.
