This series contains the successful contracts for AEPB. The contracts have been numbered and are usually prefixed with a letter. The early contracts dating from 1911-27 had no numbers attached, thus item numbers were allocated by the archivist. The more common letter prefix for the contracts are C = construction and cables, S = switchgear and substations, and T = transformers, trenching and excavating.

Most contracts contain a specification for the job, paper for the tender and memorandum of agreement which is signed and stamped. A number of contracts are missing.
