

## **EPA Lodgement Checklist**

## Checklist for lodgement of application for Engineering Approval for public drainage, watermain and road works

An Engineering Approval is generally required by a clause in the Subdivision Consent Conditions which requires fulfillment before a 224C Certificate is issued.

The following items of information are required before an Engineering Approval for public drainage, watermain and road works may be issued:

O Completed application form signed by chartered professional engineer /licensed cadastral surveyor, applicant and agent (if applicable)
O Three sets of plans including an A3 set, named, dated and uniquely numbered. Digital PDF files should also be included
O Relevant engineering standard details
O Catchment plans (where appropriate, e.g. drainage, watermains)
O Any relevant correspondence between the council, Watercare Services Limited and Auckland Transport and the applicant or their agent, regarding this work
O Sketch of proposed works on council's service plans
O Site photographs (for design context)
O Supporting calculations
O Permission from affected public and private land owners for work on their land
O Details of tree protection, arborist report or tree Approval
O Details of other services:
O Other approvals granted:

If ALL the above documentation is provided, the Engineering Approval for public drainage, watermain and road works should be approved within 20 working days.
