

Creative Community Scheme Auckland Funded Projects 2022/2023

In 2022-2023, Auckland Creative Communities Scheme assessment committees granted \$1,337,868 to support 246 local projects.

The Creative Communities Scheme has created opportunities for 20,752 people of all ages to actively participate in local arts activities, with a projected audience of over 500,000 people. The scheme enables communities to bring art into the everyday lives of Aucklanders across the region on beaches, in parks, on marae, in community halls, theatres, streets and galleries with music, dance, film-making, weaving, whakairo, sculpting, singing, poetry, theatre – a wide range creative cultural expression in many art forms within our community. capable of becoming the ‘cornerstones’ of a thriving arts and culture sector in Auckland.
