Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

14 Please comment on the ways in which you believe the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 is achieving its object.

Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 object:

- : Amendments which could be made to the Act to improve communities' input and the effectiveness of the development and implementation of local alcohol polices are (see also attached submission):
- a. Enabling councils to negotiate amendments to their policy to address issues raised in appeals without having to concede that an element is unreasonable (as is currently required in the Authority).
- b. Allowing elements of a local alcohol policy which have not been appealed against to be brought into force immediately. The effect of an appeal against a local alcohol policy delays the application of all of the policy until all appeals are finally dealt with. A better process could mirror that found in section 86F of the Resource Management Act 1991 which allows unopposed elements, or elements where appeals have been determined, to come into force immediately.
- c. Confirming the matters a council must have regard to when it is directed by the Authority to reconsider an element.
- d. Reducing the number of opportunities for appeals to be made or at least making it clear that only specific parts of a local alcohol policy which have been amended by a council following direction from the Authority can be appealed.
