Auckland Council Unitary Plan Appeals

Auckland Unitary Plan rural subdivision provisions operative – 11 June 2021

At its meeting on 6 May 2021, the Auckland Council noted that section 152 of the Local Government (Auckland Transitional Provisions) Act 2010 deems those parts of the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan no longer under appeal to have been approved by the council. On this basis the rural subdivision provisions that were subject to appeal are deemed to have been approved by the Council. The Council requested that staff complete, as soon as practicable, the necessary statutory steps to publicly notify the Auckland Unitary Plan Operative in part.

Pursuant to section 160 of the Local Government (Auckland Transitional Provisions) Act 2010 (LGATPA) and clause 20 of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA), the Auckland Council gives notice that the rural subdivision provisions set out in the following link will be made operative on 11 June 2021. The Auckland Unitary Plan will be updated accordingly.
