 - 1.1. K Vernon v Auckland Council, ENV-2016-AKL-000243.
- 2. I am a person who made a further submission about the subject matter of the proceedings.
- 3. I am not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C or 308CA of the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA).
- 4. I am interested in part of the proceedings. The part of the proceedings I am interested in is K Vernon's appeal against a decision of the Auckland Council on the proposed Auckland Unitary Plan in relation to Topic 041, Earthworks and Minerals Kauri dieback (refer paragraphs 99-103 of K Vernon Notice of Appeal).

- a) Recognise and provide for the protection of areas of significant indigenous vegetation and significant habitat of indigenous fauna;
- b) Give effect to the Regional Policy Statement; and
- c) Promote the sustainable management of natural and physical resources.
- 7. I agree to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.
