NOTICE OF PERSON'S WISH TO BE PARTY TO PROCEEDINGS

1. **Wesley College Trust Board and Grafton Downs Limited ("Wesley") wishes to be party to the following proceedings:**

- (a) *Transpower New Zealand Limited v Auckland Council* ENV-2014-AKL-000218

being an appeal lodged by Transpower New Zealand Limited ("Transpower") under section 156(3) of the Local Government (Auckland Transitional Provisions) Act 2010 in respect of a decision on the extent of the National Grid Corridor Overlay in the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan.

2. **Wesley has an interest in the proceedings that is greater than the public generally because:**

- (a) Wesley made submissions and further submissions on the provisions of the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan relating to the National Grid Corridor Overlay and its extent.
- (b) Wesley owns approximately 300 hectares of green field land at Paerata North ("the Site") which has been identified as a Special Housing Area. Transpower's 220kv transmission lines to Glenbrook bisect the Site.
- (c) Wesley obtained a plan variation under the Housing Accords and Special Housing Areas Act 2013 to rezone the Site to enable development of a new town of approximately 5,000 dwellings.
- (d) The provisions of the National Grid Corridor Overlay will limit Wesley's ability to develop the part of the Site to which it applies.
- (e) The changes to the extent of the National Grid Corridor Overlay sought by Transpower would extend the overlay over a much greater proportion of the Site, with consequent impacts on Wesley's ability to develop its land.

3. **Wesley is not a trade competitor for the purposes of section 308C of the Resource Management Act 1991 ("RMA").**

4. **Wesley is interested in all the proceedings.**

5. **Wesley opposes the relief sought by Transpower. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the reasons for opposition are:**

- (a) The relief sought does not promote the sustainable management of natural and physical resources in accordance with section 5 of the RMA;
- (b) The relief sought does not enable the community to provide for its social and economic wellbeing in accordance with section 5(2) of the RMA;

(c) The relief sought does not provide for the efficient use and development of natural and physical resources in accordance with section 7(b) of the RMA.

6. **Wesley agrees to participate in mediation or other alternative dispute resolution of the proceedings.**
