Auckland Council

31 May 2018 - Regional Coastal Plan becomes Operative in Part

On 11 May 2018 the Minister of Conservation approved the Regional Coastal Plan provisions of the Auckland Unitary Plan (except those subject to two High Court appeals) in accordance with clause 19(4) of Schedule 1 to the Resource Management Act 1991 (RMA).

The approved Regional Coastal Plan provisions incorporated various amendments required to be made by the Minister of Conservation pursuant to clause 19(1) of Schedule 1 to the RMA.

Pursuant to clause 20 of Schedule 1 to the RMA, and section 160 of the Local Government (Auckland Transitional Provisions) Act 2010, the Auckland Council hereby gives notice that the Regional Coastal Plan provisions (except those subject to appeal) shall become 'Operative in Part' on **Thursday, 31 May 2018**.

Exclusions

The Auckland Unitary Plan (Operative in Part) has been annotated to identify those provisions of the Proposed Auckland Unitary Plan which are excluded from operative approval, namely those provisions that remain subject to appeal.
