Reasons

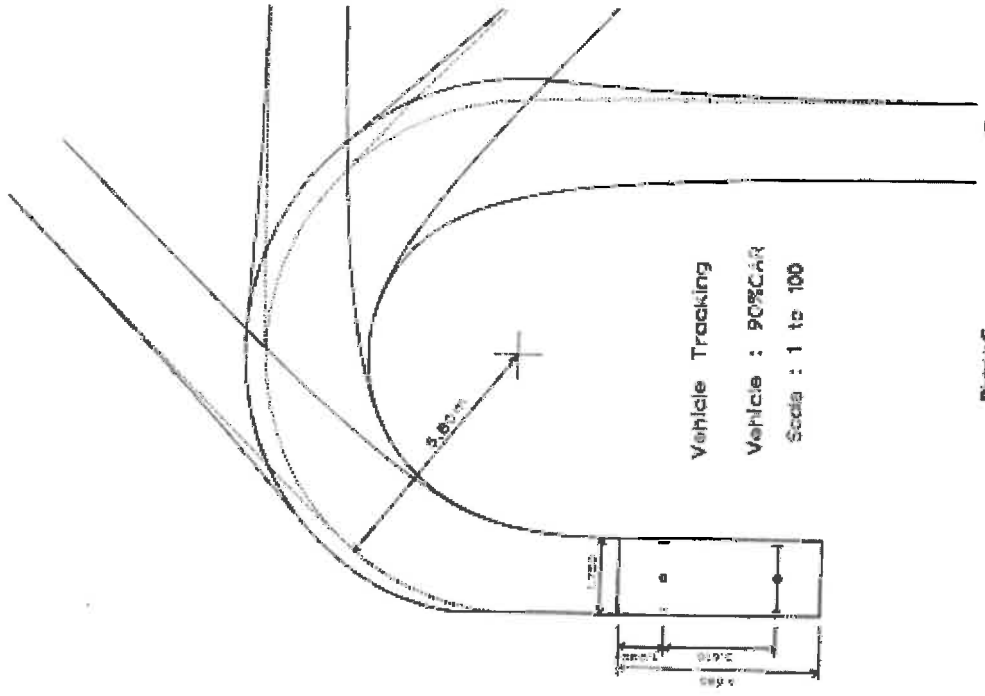
Although the legacy North Shore City Council district plan is the only district plan to include a definition of 'transport equipment', provision needs to be made in the Unitary Plan for these things. The definition relates to rules that may be required to manage effects within the road corridor.

Manukau	<p>Manukau means the whole of any land within the City and which immediately before the commencement of Part XXI of the Local Government Act 1974 was a road or street or public highway, or is laid out by the Council as a road or street after the commencement of this Act, or is vested in the Council for the purpose of a road as shown on a deposited survey plan, or is vested in the Council as a road or street pursuant to any other enactment. It excludes service lanes. Road types are classified as per Appendix 2 contained within Chapter 9 of the Plan.</p>

Papakura	<p>Papakura- Plan change 13 Road Has the same meaning as in section 315 of the Local Government Act 1974 and includes a motorway as defined in section 2(1) of the Transit New Zealand Act 1989</p>
Rodney	<p>Rodney means any motorway, STATE HIGHWAY, FORMED or unfomed ROAD, proposed road, road reserve, limited access road or street. [Amendment 107 Decision Report 2277]</p>
Waitakere	<p>Waitakere has the meaning set out in section 2(1) of the Act and includes <i>land</i> vested in or to be vested in Council as <i>road</i>, State Highways and motorways, and includes <i>land</i> within the <i>road</i> and any <i>carrageway</i>, footpath or berm. For the purposes of <i>financial contributions</i>, <i>roads</i> also includes passenger transport facilities, traffic control and traffic management devices, traffic calming measures, <i>landscape treatment</i> within the <i>road</i> berm and cycleways, regardless of whether these items are vested in, or to be vested in Council</p>

10 METRES FOR A MEDIUM RIGID TRUCK (MRT)**

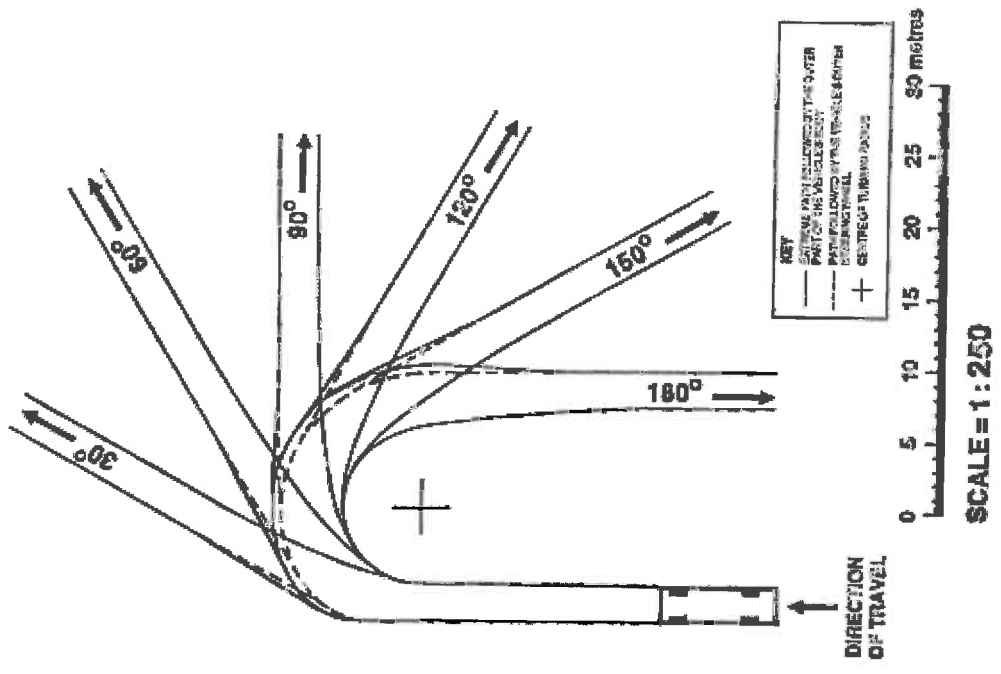

Road: means the same as in section 2 of the RMA as it was in December 2012, that is:

road means the whole of any land which is within a district, and which—

- (a) immediately before the commencement of this Part was a road or street or public highway; or
- (b) immediately before the inclusion of any area in the district was a public highway within that area; or
- (c) is laid out by the council as a road or street after the commencement of this Part; or
- (d) is vested in the council for the purpose of a road as shown on a deposited survey plan; or

(e) is vested in the council as a road or street pursuant to any other enactment;—
and includes—

(f) except where elsewhere provided in this Part, any access way or service lane which before the commencement of this Part was under the control of any council or is laid out or constructed by or vested in any council as an access way or service lane or is declared by the Minister of Works and Development as an access way or service lane after the commencement of this Part or is declared by the Minister of Lands as an access way or service lane on or after 1 April 1988:

(g) every square or place intended for use of the public generally, and every bridge, culvert, drain, ford, gate, building, or other thing belonging thereto or lying upon the line or within the limits thereof;—

but, except as provided in the Public Works Act 1981 or in any regulations under that Act, does not include a motorway within the meaning of that Act or the Government Roadway Powers Act 1989.

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Reasons

This definition gives effect to subdivision and development rules.
