#### Comments:

One Copper skink (Cyclodina aenea) was observed during the earthworks of the access track.

PAPs have been delineated with hi-vis flagging tape by the supervising arborist. - Flagging tape checked All work is outside the PAP's

An Ecologist was on site today supporting the ecological outcomes, working with the Tree Feller and the excavator, to locate and recover indigenous skinks if discovered during the works.

as a precautionary measure the ecologist continues to conduct a pre-works bird nest survey, before works got underway. No bird nests were found in this search.

Machine Placement: On access track

Felling Method: Scarf Cut, back cut, and pushed with an excavator
